GENERAL NOTES:

- School uniform must be worn at all times when attending school, and students must be smartly presented.
- Footwear must be navy blue or black shoes without motifs, high heels or platform soles. Trainers are only to be worn for P.E.
- No extreme haircuts or colour-dyed hair are allowed
- Trousers must be a tailored fit. They must not be denim or jeans-style and must not have external pockets
- Plain coats/jackets without large logos may be worn outside
- Girls' skirts must be loose fitting
- Boys may wear a watch, but no other jewellery
- Girls may wear a watch and one pair of small stud earrings – no other jewellery, piercings, make-up or nail varnish are allowed.
- Students may wear a blue school cap (*) or plain black hat – this should be removed when inside the buildings
- If girls wish to wear a headscarf/veil, this must be black or navy blue
